Al Marjan Island: Our Flagship

Extending 4.5 km into the Arabian Gulf, Al Marjan Island stands as our flagship development. It has been masterplanned as a world-class, sustainable, beach resort community, fully sold out as of January 2024.

With hospitality, residential, commercial, and mixed-use projects, the island embodies Marjan's vision: creating destinations that enhance Ras Al Khaimah's appeal for investors, residents, and visitors alike.





Marjan Beach: The Next Chapter

At the meeting point of Ras Al Khaimah's sea, desert, and mountains, Marjan Beach takes shape as the Emirate's new waterfront district. More than a shoreline, it is a connected place, where neighborhoods, open spaces, and cultural anchors come together to create a complete lifestyle.

Designed for Growth and Livability

Marjan Beach brings to life the ambition to create a global coastal destination that is as livable as it is inspiring. With modern residential communities, world-class leisure, and thoughtfully designed public spaces, it sets the stage for Ras Al Khaimah's next era.



A Destination Shaped by Land and Sea

Set along a rare 3-kilometer stretch of coastline, Marjan Beach is defined by the natural character of Ras Al Khaimah; the sea, the desert, and the mountains. These landscapes anchor its identity, ensuring the development belongs uniquely to this place and nowhere else.

Comfort in the Outdoors

Every detail of Marjan Beach is planned to make the outdoors part of daily life. Shaded walkways, cycling paths, and green corridors soften the climate, while parks and ecological networks weave neighborhoods together.





A Waterfront Designed for Life

Unlike many coastal destinations that are seasonal, Majan Beach is programmed to thrive year-round. Its design blends soft, natural beachfronts with engineered edges to create spaces that are at once recreational, residential, and cultural.

- The Corniche – a continuous waterfront promenade alive with dining, retail, and everyday gatherings.
- The Public Beach – a one-kilometer stretch of activated shoreline, rare in the UAE for its accessibility and scale.
- Parks & Green Networks – shaded trails, gardens, and ecological zones weaving neighborhoods together.







Neighborhoods with Character

Marjan Beach brings together a collection of neighborhoods, each offering its own sense of place. Some are lively and social, designed for gatherings and everyday encounters. Others are more private, shaped for quiet living and reflection. Parks, walkways, and open spaces connect them all, creating a community that is diverse in spirit yet harmonious in experience.

Anchors of Culture and Commerce

Beyond homes and leisure, Marjan Beach is designed as a destination:

- A convention center for global gatherings.
- A regional retail hub with international reach.
- A botanical garden celebrating nature and education.

These anchors make Marjan Beach not only a place to live, but also a center of culture and commerce for Ras Al Khaimah.



On a Grand Scale

Marjan Beach is designed at a scale that matches its ambition. Spanning 85 million sq ft, the community will bring together homes, schools, workplaces, and leisure spaces in one connected destination, all framed by a 3 km beachfront.

With a gross floor area of 75 million sq ft, the development will feature 22,000 residential units, supported by 1.5 million sq ft of education facilities and vibrant retail across 3.5 million sq ft.

Hospitality will also play a defining role, with 12,000 hotel keys across 12 million sq ft, complemented by a 500,000 sq ft convention centre and civic institutions. A dedicated Techflex zone of 12 million sq ft ensures the district is future-ready, supporting innovation alongside daily life.

In total, Marjan Beach is planned to welcome 74,000 residents, 32,000 workers, and 180,000 annual visitors. All are connected by over 9 million sq ft of green and open spaces, including public parks, shaded walkways, cycling tracks, and micromobility networks, making the outdoors a central part of everyday life.
